The Stewards received through the FIA Technical Delegate a report by the chief national scrutineer stating that the crew of car No. 42 drove straight over the STOP-sign set up by them to indicate the tyre checking zone after SS10. The car then stopped approximately 25 metres behind the checking point. The scrutineers' report also stated that the car had problems with the brakes and that all this resulted in a very dangerous situation.

The Stewards then summoned and heard the representative of the Competitor, Mrs Severine Labaune, on 29th July 2017 at 10.45 hrs.

During the hearing Mrs. Labaune stated, on behalf of the drivers, that the car had no more brakes when the incident occurred and that the driver was very stressed and upset for this situation. He was thus not concentrated on identifying the STOP sign and saw it only at the last moment, therefore failing to stop the car properly. She added that it was not at all the driver's intention to create an unsafe situation and apologized for his lapse.


Upon the comment of the Stewards that the driver should at least have tried to signal in whatever way that he was not able to stop the car, she fully agreed.

The Stewards, having considered all the circumstances and statements made, conclude that a breach of Article 12.1.1.i of the 2017 FIA International Sporting Code has been committed and after due deliberation


DECIDE

to impose a **Fine of € 400** onto the Competitor of car No. 42.
